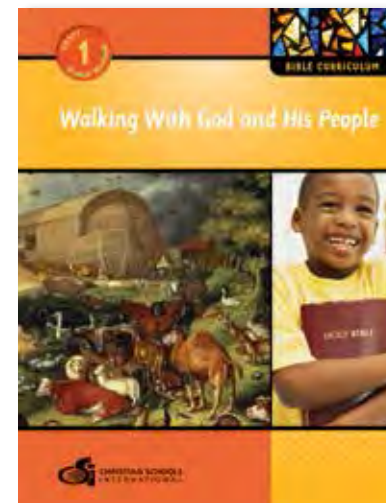
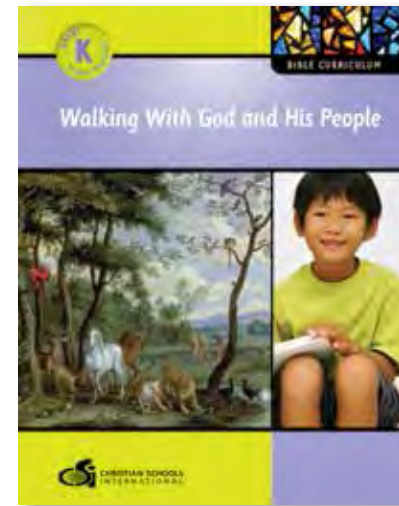


## PreK

Focusing on God's care for his people, students dig deeper into the Old and New Testaments to discover the connections between them. Workbook activities support Bible passages and memorization.

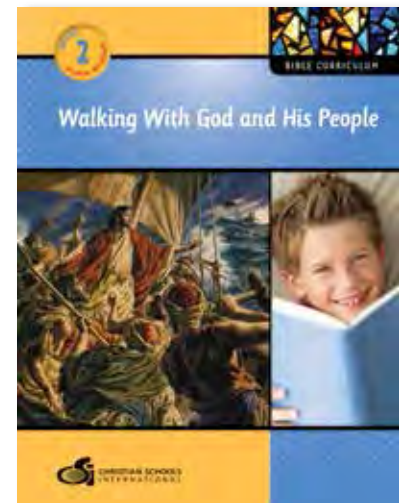


## Grade 1

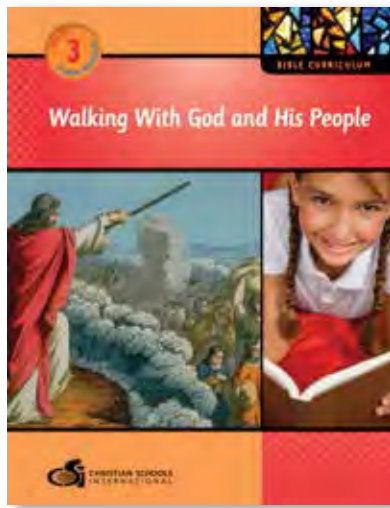

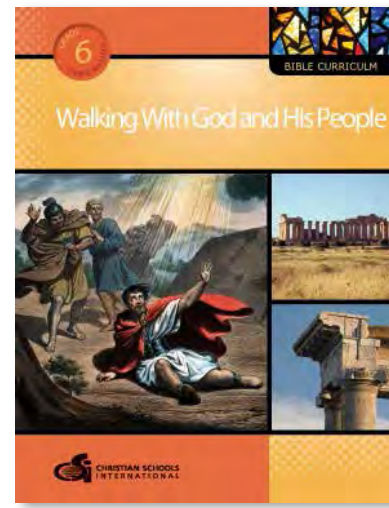
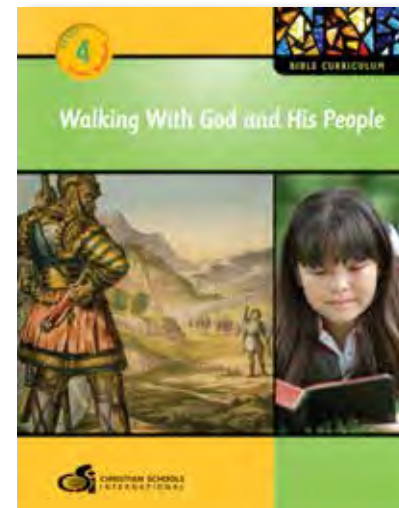


### Grade 3

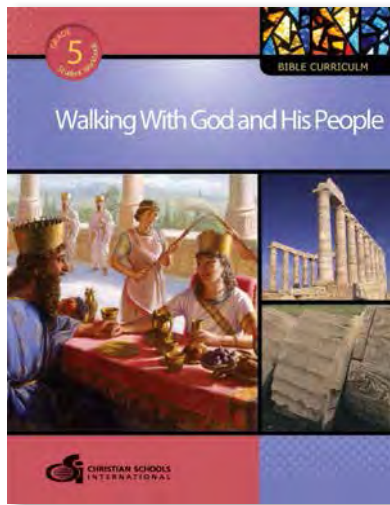
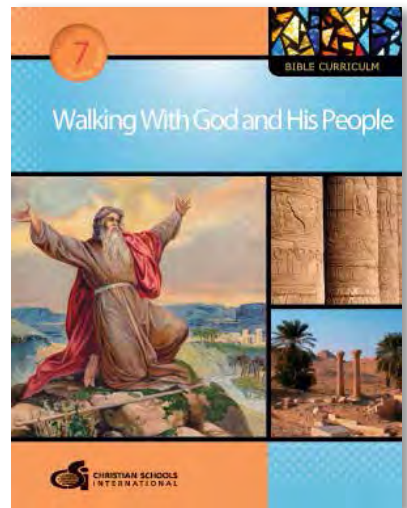


### Grade 6

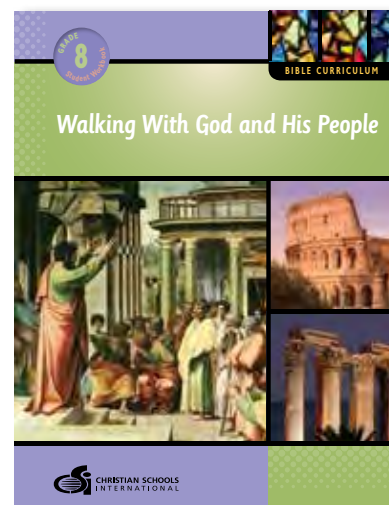
### Grade 7
