- Tweak by Hand
  When Needed
  Final edits ensure relevance.
- Verify with Organic Intelligence
  Check Al for accuracy.

- Yes, Al is Biased:
  Recognize and account for bias.
- Don't Enter Sensitive Data Protect student privacy.
- Stay Reflective

  Monitor Al's impact on you and your students.
